### **TWO SPARTANBURG MEN ARRESTED ON TRAFFICKING COCAINE CHARGES**

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division's Piedmont agents announce the arrest of two Spartanburg men on several drug charges.

Jerome Maurice Foster, 21, of 121 Wrightson Avenue, Spartanburg, S.C., and David Michael Pilgrim, 21, of 439 Beacon Street, Spartanburg, S.C., are each charged with one count of **Trafficking Cocaine, Possession with Intent to Distribute Cocaine and Possession of Weapons during the Commission of a Felony.**

According to investigators, these alleged crimes happened on or near October 23, 2008.

With a search warrant, SLED agents seized 38 grams of powder cocaine with an approximate street value of \$1,000, three handguns, one rifle and approximately \$700.00 in cash inside 726 Wofford Street, Spartanburg, S.C.

The Spartanburg Public Safety Department assisted with this investigation.

**Trafficking Cocaine** is a felony offense punishable up to 25 years in prison and/or fined up to \$50,000.

**Possession With Intent to Distribute Cocaine** is a felony offense punishable up to 15 years in prison or fined not more than \$25,000 or both.

**Possession of Weapons during the Commission of a Felony** is a felony offense punishable up to 5 years in prison.
