## **LAKE CITY RESIDENT ARRESTED ON NEGLECT CHARGES**

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division's (SLED) Special Victims Unit Agents announce the arrest of a Lake City man on allegations he exploited and neglected a vulnerable adult.

Alan Ross Shelley, 52, of Room 113 at The Holiday Inn Express, 202 Ron McNair Blvd., Lake City, SC, is charged with **Exploitation of a Vulnerable Adult and Neglect of a Vulnerable Adult**.

Alan Shelley is accused of improperly using his late aunt, 81-year-old Katherine Carlsten Shelley's personal funds for his own and his acquaintances use.

He is also accused of failing to provide Ms. Shelley with the proper medication she required.

It is believed that the accused neglect placed her at substantial risk for her death.

These allegations happened between July 24, 2007 and September 14, 2007.

Ms. Shelley, who was considered to be a Vulnerable Adult, had a physical condition that impaired her from adequately taking care of herself.

Alan Shelley was her caregiver and power of attorney.

If convicted of both felonies, Alan Shelley could face a fine of not more than \$5,000 or imprisoned not more than five (5) years.
