COLUMBIA MAN CHARGED WITH ASSAULTING RICHLAND COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPUTY

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division's (SLED) Midlands Agents announce the arrest of a Columbia man accused of striking a Richland County Sheriff's deputy with a vehicle.

Brian Lamonte Waden, 22, of 822 Woodside Avenue, Columbia, S.C. is charged with **Assault and Battery with Intent to Kill**.

According to an arrest warrant, Waden intentionally hit a Richland County Sheriff's Deputy with a 2000 Ford Focus, causing injury on November 28, 2008.

The incident happened at 2008 Faraway Drive in Columbia. (The Reserve Apartments).

Assault and Battery with Intent to Kill is a felony offense punishable up to twenty (20) years in prison.

Waden is expected to be in Richland County bond court at 8 o'clock tonight.
