TAYLORS MAN CHARGED WITH BRIBING AN UNDERCOVER SLED AGENT

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division's (SLED) Piedmont Agents announce the arrest of a Taylors man accused of offering bribes to an undercover SLED Agent.

Quoc Phan, 34, of 111 Eagle Pass Drive, Taylors, S.C., is charged with **Giving or Offering Bribes to Officers.**

According to an arrest warrant, Phan offered the undercover SLED Agent hundreds of dollars to alter S.C. State Cosmetology Board testing procedures.

Investigators say Phan believed the Agent was a State Board Examination proctor for the School of Cosmetology.

Phan allegedly asked the undercover SLED Agent to accept the money in order to take Cosmetology tests for roughly 30-40 people at a cost of \$500 each.

The State Board of Cosmetology's Labor, Licensing and Regulation Board assisted with this investigation.

Giving or Offering Bribes to Officers is punishable up to five (5) years in prison.
