### **CLINTON WOMAN CHARGED WITH LYING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT**

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) announces the arrest of a Clinton woman on accusations that she filed a false police report.

Lisa Campbell Kizer, 44, of 303 Popular Lane, Clinton, S.C., is charged with **Filing a False Police Report**.

According to an arrest warrant, Kizer knowingly and willfully filed a false police report with the Clinton Police Department on December 27, 2008.

She is accused of reporting that a male committed sexual battery on her by using aggravated force in her vehicle and residence on December 26, 2008.

The warrant also says, Kizer gave a voluntary, written statement about the alleged assault and admitted that the allegations were false.

**Filing a False Police Report** is a felony offense punishable up to five (5) years in prison and/or fines.
