ALLENDALE COUNTY MAN ARRESTED IN 2007 MURDER INVESTIGATION

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division's (SLED) Low Country Region announces the arrest of an Allendale County man accused of murder.

Marquis Sentell Breeland, 25, of 349 Bing Street, Allendale, S.C., is charged with **Murder** and **Possession of a Weapon During the Commission of Violent Crime**.

Breeland allegedly shot and killed Laurice Garvin with a 9 mm handgun on July 22, 2007 in Allendale County.

According to arrest warrants and affidavits, Breeland is accused of making comments about committing this crime.

The Allendale County Sheriff's Department and the Allendale Police Department assisted with this investigation.

Murder is punishable by death, life in prison or a mandatory minimum of thirty (30) years in prison.

Possession of a Weapon During a Violent Crime is punishable up to five (5) years in prison.
