LANCASTER COUNTY AMBER ALERT UPDATE

Lancaster County Sheriff Barry Faile and The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division continue to ask for the public's help in locating 29-year-old Gerardo Reyes-Campos.

He is accused of stabbing his common law wife, 22-year-old Diane Madisol Trejo and taking their two children, 3-year-old Melanie Reyes and 1-year-old Destiny Reyes from a Lancaster County home located at 2020 Santa Barbara Drive on Thursday night.

Last night, Reyes-Campos was seen with the children traveling in a tan 2000 Isuzu Trooper with South Carolina tags BJD-238.

The Amber Alert is still active in this case.

Gerardo Reyes-Campos should be considered armed and dangerous. Use extreme caution if you see him. Call 9-1-1 immediately.

The Lancaster County Sheriff's Office received a 9-1-1 call around 8:15 Thursday night from Trejo's neighbor in reference to a stabbing at a Lancaster County home.

When deputies arrived at the location, they found Trejo with a 2 ½ to 3 inch long stab wound to her neck.

Deputies secured the scene for EMS officials to arrive.

Emergency personnel airlifted Trejo to Palmetto Health Richland Hospital in Columbia, S.C.

At last check, she was in critical, but stable condition.

When he's captured, Gerardo Reyes-Campos will be charged by the Lancaster County Sheriff's Office with Assault and Battery with Intent to Kill and charges to be determined in relation to the abduction

That agency has previously charged Reyes-Campos with criminal domestic violence and cocaine distribution.

Note to media: Citizens should call 9-1-1 immediately if they see Reyes-Campos, the children or the vehicle described previously.
