BERKELEY COUNTY INMATE CHARGED WITH MURDER

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) announces that an inmate who is currently serving time at Hill-Finklea Detention Center in Berkeley County, S.C., has been charged with murder.

Andres Leroy Glenn, 47, of 111 Bryant Ridge Lane, Lot 2, Moncks Corner, S.C. is charged with **Murder**.

According to an arrest warrant, Glenn removed a metal apparatus from a wheel chair and hit Nathaniel Sanders with it on his head.

That impact caused Sanders to suffer from blunt force trauma.

The crime allegedly happened inside a jail cell on February 23, 2009 between the hours of 7:00 and 7:25 in the evening.

Sanders was transported to the Medical University of Charleston (MUSC) on March 4, 2009 and was pronounced dead.

Murder is a felony offense punishable up to life in prison or the death penalty.

SLED is investigating this case at the request of the Berkeley County Sheriff's Department.
