LEXINGTON COUNTY MAN CHARGED IN OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING INVESTIGATION

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) announces the arrest of a Swansea man accused of trying to strike a South Carolina Highway Patrolman with a vehicle.

Gregory Mark Crolley, 42, of 528 Guss Sturkie Road, Swansea, S.C., is charged with Two (2) Counts of **Assault with Intent to Kill**.

According to arrest warrants, Crolley did attempt to strike several times, two alleged victims, State Trooper Drew Ledbetter and Amelia Joye Crolley with a 2001 Chevrolet Cavalier on March 16, 2009.

The alleged incident happened during a traffic stop on Highway 6 in Swansea.

Assault with Intent to Kill is a felony offense punishable up to twenty (20) years in prison.
