### **GREENWOOD COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPUTY CHARGED WITH MISCONDUCT IN OFFICE**

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) announces the arrest of a Greenwood County Sheriff's deputy accused of possessing stolen goods.

Scott Bradford Masterson, 36, of 630 South Mill Street is charged with **Misconduct In Office**.

According to an arrest warrant, Masterson did in Abbeville County, willfully, intentionally and dishonestly with bad faith and corrupt intent engage in acts of misconduct in office by committing acts and omissions in breach of his duties of good faith, honesty and accountability.

SLED agents say Masterson possessed stolen farming equipment at his Abbeville County home.

The crime allegedly happened between September 1, 2008 and April 2, 2009.

SLED investigated this case at the request of the Greenwood County Sheriff's Office.

That agency and The Abbeville County Sheriff's Office assisted with this investigation.

Masterson turned himself in to SLED agents at the Abbeville County Sheriff's Office today.

More charges against Masterson are pending.
