### **SLED SERVES 108 WARRANTS AGAINST HAMPTON COUNTY MAN CHARGED IN AUTO FRAUD INVESTIGATION**

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) announces the arrest of a Hampton County man accused of multiple automobile fraud charges.

Anthony S. Cook, 52, of 6845 Pocotaligo Road, Hampton, S.C., is charged with thirty-one (31) counts of **Breach of Trust with Fraudulent Intent**, twenty-seven (27) counts of **Permitting Misuse of Title, Registration or License Plate**, twenty-two (22) counts of **Alteration or Forgery of Document**, nineteen (19) counts of **Disposing Property Under Lien** and nine (9) counts of **Fraudulent Sale of Personal/Real Property**.

According to 108 arrest warrants the crimes allegedly happened from January to December of 2008 in Hampton County.

Among the accusations, Cook received thousands of dollars from several alleged victim's after they purchased vehicles from "Andy's Auto Sales" and failed to notify financial institutions that he repossessed those vehicles before the date of sale.

Cook is further accused of not delivering title and registration numbers of several vehicles to alleged victims.
