GEORGETOWN COUNTY MAN ARRESTED IN CHILD PORNOGRAPHY INVESTIGATION

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) announces the arrest of a Georgetown County man accused of having child pornography on his computer.

Jeremy Godwin, 21 of 16898 County Line Road, Andrews, S.C. is charged with **Second Degree Sexual Exploitation of a Minor**.

According to an arrest warrant, Godwin had visual materials depicting minors engaged in sexual activity on a computer at his home.

With a search warrant, SLED agents confiscated electronic media from Godwin's residence during an undercover operation.

This is the 235th Sexual Exploitation/Criminal Solicitation case investigated by the SC Computer Crimes Center.

The Georgetown County Sheriff's Office assisted with this investigation.

Second Degree Sexual Exploitation of a Minor is a felony offense punishable up to ten (10) years in prison.
