AIKEN COUNTY DETENTION CENTER INMATE ACCUSED OF KILLING FELLOW INMATE

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) is charging an Aiken County Detention Center inmate with the death of a fellow inmate.

Andrew Nathan York, 37, of 361 Outing Club Road, Aiken, S.C. is accused of **Murder**.

According to an arrest warrant, York used his fist to hit the victim, 55-year-old Dale Sengelman in the face.

As a result, Sengelman fell backwards onto a concrete floor of a common area at the Detention Center causing a fracture to his head.

Sengelman was transported to a local hospital where he was pronounced dead.

The crime allegedly happened on April 28, 2009.

Murder is a felony offense punishable by death, life in prison or a mandatory minimum of thirty (30) years in prison.

The Aiken County Sheriff's Office assisted with this investigation.
