FORT LAWN POLICE CHIEF ARRESTED IN MISCONDUCT INVESTIGATION

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) announces the arrest of the Fort Lawn Police Chief who is accused of stealing money during an investigation.

John Michael Revels, 42, of 161 Forest Lakes Circle, Great Falls, S.C., is charged with **Misconduct In Office (Common Law)**.

According to investigators, Revels stole approximately \$100 of \$200 from a victim in an investigation conducted by the Great Falls Police Department on or about March 31, 2007 in Chester County.

These accusations stem from when Revels was the Police Chief in the town of Great Falls.

Revels turned himself in to SLED agents today in Chester County.

Misconduct In Office (Common Law) is a misdemeanor offense punishable at the discretion of the court.
