### **UNION COUNTY TEACHER ARRESTED IN CHILD PORNOGRAPHY INVESTIGATION**

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) announces the arrest of a Union County Elementary School teacher who is accused of downloading pornographic pictures of children on a computer.

Samuel Roger Worley, Jr., 46, of 332 Belvue Drive, Union, S.C., is charged with **Second Degree Sexual Exploitation of a Minor**.

According to investigators, Worley downloaded and disseminated sexually explicit materials of minors on a computer at his home.

With a search warrant, SLED agents confiscated electronic media from Worley's home during an undercover, proactive investigation.

This is the 237<sup>th</sup> Sexual Exploitation case investigated by the SC Computer Crimes Center.

The Union County Sheriff's Office assisted with this investigation.

**Second Degree Sexual Exploitation of a Minor** is a felony offense punishable up to ten (10) years in prison.

The case will be prosecuted by the SC Attorney General's Office as part of the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force (ICAC).
