### **SIX ORANGEBURG COUNTY BANK ROBBERS ARRESTED**

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) announces the arrest of six Summerville men accused of robbing a bank in Holly Hill, S.C.

Ethrum Henri-K Jenkins, John B. Drayton, Marcus Charles Irick, Reginald Leonard Pringle, Junior and Jubraie Rondell Pringle are charged with **Armed Robbery of a Bank**.

Christopher Allen Silva is charged with **Two Counts of Accessory Before the Fact of a Felony**.

According to arrest warrants, Jenkins, Drayton, Irick and the Pringle's entered the Farmers and Merchants Bank of South Carolina located at 8624 Old State Road in the Town of Holly Hill with the intent to steal money.

The men robbed the bank with handguns and used force, intimidation and threats of bodily harm against people inside the bank on June 25, 2009.

The men stole an undisclosed amount of money.

Arrest warrants also say that Silva counseled, aided and abetted his co-defendants in committing the armed robbery by providing a get away vehicle after the crime.

SLED's Fugitive Team, The Bloodhound Tracking Team and The Holly Hill Police Department assisted with this investigation.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) was notified at the time of the crime.
