SLED AGENT ARRESTED ON LARCENY CHARGES

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) announces the arrest of a SLED agent from Allendale County accused of stealing gasoline.

Ronnie Smith, 46, of 380 7th Street East, Fairfax, S.C. is charged with **three counts of Larceny (Petit or Simple)** and one count of **Misconduct in Office (Common Law)**.

According to arrest warrants, Smith is accused of using a state issued gasoline credit card to purchase gas for his personal vehicles and a gas can between the dates of November 2007 to October 2009.

Smith was arrested yesterday afternoon in Allendale County.

He was assigned to the Low Country Region and became a SLED agent in 1985.

Smith was terminated from SLED on October 14, 2009 while the agency obtained warrants for his arrest.

Larceny (Petit or Simple) is a misdemeanor punishable by fines or imprisonment not more than is permitted by law without presentment or indictment by the grand jury.

Misconduct in Office (Common Law) is an offense punishable at the discretion of the court.
